- Furthering Student Engagement
  - Technology
    - October Pro-D Google Apps for Education EA's and teacher partners at Monterey
    - November Pro-D Google Summit at Oak Bay High experts from US, 4-500 teachers attending including 13 Monterey teachers
    - Natalie, parent, voiced concern around Freedom of Information/Privacy. Has not signed permission form at this point. Server in US not under strict Canadian privacy laws.
  - o Meaningful Assessment

    - Percentage based grades not mandatory until Grade 11
    - Middle schools teachers have 3 report cards options: MyEd (classic reporting), CSL (competencies + grade), Fresh Grade (ongoing parent communications, just grades reported at end of term)
    - Families will be informed of varying reporting options available to teachers reporting will vary by class
