Thrifty Foods Smile Card Program

The Monterey PAC is once again participating in the Thrifty Foods Smile Card fundraising program. The Smile Card operates like a reusable gift card: when you load money onto it using cash, credit or debit, 5% of that amount is paid back to the school (to a maximum of \$2,500) to be put towards new playground equipment.

There is no cost to you and you can still collect AirMiles on your purchases.

Simply take your Smile Card with you to any Thrifty Foods grocery store and ask Customer Service or your cashier to load an amount of your choice onto the card <u>BEFORE</u> your grocery order is rung through, then use it to pay.

When the card balance is running low, load more money onto it to continue to support your school. Your Smile Card can be used for most purchases: groceries, party platters, floral, tobacco, Lotto, BC Transit passes, Mt. Washington lift passes and any other passes Thrifty Foods may sell. It cannot be used at Thrifty Foods Liquor stores or for the purchase of gift cards.
