Get started:

1. Go to <https://fundraising.purdys.com>
2. Register as a NEW CUSTOMER or sign in if you have an existing account.
3. For NEW CUSTOMERS only, click “Register as a Supporter”. Then VERY IMPORTANT!! - **Enter our Customer Number 25366**. After that, fill in your details.
4. On the Monterey Music Program Fundraiser page, click on the “SHOP ONLINE” tab at the top of the screen. Click on “USE ONLINE ORDER FORM”.
5. On the order form, fill in the ADDITIONAL INFORMATION field with the name of the student that you are supporting. This student will receive 25% of all chocolate sales from you and your friends. This money will be added to the student’s individual account, defraying cost for future music trips!
6. Shop online and pay for your order.
7. To invite your friends and family to join in the fundraiser, use the “SEND INVITES” tab at the top of the screen. Just remind them to enter your child’s name in the “ADDITIONAL INFO” box.

Monterey Music Program Purdy's Chocolates Fundraiser FAQs

What is the purpose of this fundraiser?

To support the Monterey music program. With this fundraiser, Purdy's gives back 25% of the sales to us. This amount gets credited to your child's fundraising account to defray the cost of the Grade 7 and 8 band trips in the spring. If your child is in grade 6, any money raised will be held for them to use in Grade 7 or 8.

How do I get started?

Ordering is online only. If you have the Purdy's brochure, this is for reference only. Follow the instructions above, making sure to provide our customer account #25366 and the name of the student you are supporting.

How can I ensure that my child receives his/her fundraising allocation?

By entering the student's name in the ADDITIONAL INFORMATION field on the online order form. This is the only way to ensure that your child receives his/her fundraising dollars. If the coordinators are unable to match the money raised to a student in the music program, the fundraising dollars will go into our general account to benefit all students in the program.

How can I let friends and family know about this fundraiser?

You can give them a brochure with instructions included inside. Or you can click on the SEND INVITES tab on our homepage. This will email supporters a direct link to our homepage, connecting their orders to your child's account. Just remind them to include your child's name. By using this method, you can also track who is supporting your child's fundraiser.

Is this fundraiser only for families involved in the music program?

Anyone can participate in this fundraiser, even if you don't have a child in the music program! You can specify a student in the music program to receive the fundraising dollars or you can allow the 25% to be deposited into the music program's general account. The money goes towards buying sheet music, stands and instruments, and any support needed in running a successful music program.

When is the deadline for ordering?

The deadline for ordering is 27 November 2019.

When and where do I pick up my chocolates?

The chocolates will be available for pick up during the winter concert at Monterey Middle School on the evening of December 10th only. You may pick up your friends' chocolates on their behalf.

It looks like the MMPA has put in lots of work to run this fundraiser! How can I help out?

We'll need helpers to distribute the pre-packaged bags of chocolates at the Winter Concert on December 10th. Look for the volunteer online sign-up closer to the time!
