Total attendees for PAC meeting held via Zoom: 25. Acting PAC Chair and Treasurer, along with Principal Andrews, Vice-Principal Haidar and others.

- 1. Introductions (Acting Chair Krista Henry and new Treasurer Ryan Ziegler)
- 2. Administration Introductions and School Start Update

Michelle Haidar, new Monterey VP, introduced herself, and Ken Andrews gave an overview of the complexities of the return to school in the COVID-19Covid-19 pandemic:

- Staggered starts, hybrid class, different entrances, etc. all parts of a puzzle to be solved
- Although unusual, it has become somewhat normal as it becomes routine
- Students and staff have all risen to the occasion
- Overview of Monterey's current School-Wide Goals all aimed at "furthering student engagement and learning":
 - a) Increased focus on meta-cognitive reflection and social-emotional wellness
 - b) Increased focus on core & curricular competencies related to writing skills
 - c) Supporting sense-of-community & professional growth through teaming With particular mention given to the "culture" that surrounds these goals.

Principal Andrews also addressed:

- New bike racks installed and the "double the swings" construction underway on the playground
- Return_-It recycling bin has been removed for the foreseeable future due to community complaints about garbage
- Continued thinking about ways to communicate best with parents

- Three priorities for using the Canadian federal funds allocated for schools to support with COVID-19Covid 19 in terms of a. Health and Safety and b. Learning
 - a) Increasing outdoor learning spaces (possibility of some kind of covering for the inner courtyard and other options)
 - b) An additional educational assistant to meet student needs
 - c) Additional Chromebooks to assist with transition to online learning if needed

 - Catharine Meir volunteered to be Parent Education Coordinator

- Neil Marcovitz raised the issue of safe biking routes from the Willows area to
 Monterey and suggested drafting a letter to the municipality of Oak Bay; Oak Bay
 Mayor Kevin Murdoch supported discussion around this as part of the Active
 Transportation Initiative underway in the municipality.
