Thrifty Foods Smile Card program provides 6% of all Smile Cards purchased from the Monterey Middle School PAC back to the school (with a minimum of \$4,000 purchase). These funds are put towards initiatives such as new outdoor equipment, Chromebooks, Fun Foods and other initiatives in support of Monterey Middle School students and families.

Your Smile Card operates like a prepaid reusable gift card: you can still collect AirMiles on your purchases. Smile Cards can be used for most purchases: groceries, party platters, floral, tobacco, Lotto, BC Transit passes, Mt. Washington lift passes and any other passes Thrifty Foods may sell. It cannot be used at Thrifty Foods Liquor stores or for the purchase of other gift cards. More info here: [Thrifty Foods Bulk Smile Cards](#)

How does it work?

- Smile cards are available in a \$100 denomination and can be purchased directly from the PAC, not at a Thrifty Foods store.
- You can purchase multiple Smile cards at once and throughout the year.
- To order your \$100 Smile Card, follow these 2 steps:
 1. Send an Interac eTransfer of \$100 (or more if you buy more than 1 card) to smilecards@montereypac.com which will be auto-deposited (no password required)
 2. Email smilecards@montereypac.com with the email address you would like to use to arrange card pick up
- Your Smile Card can be picked up at School at the Oliver Street drop-off area once we have reached our funding goal. You will be contacted with details.
