Monterey - Code of Conduct

At Monterey we work to maintain a school environment that is welcoming and safe for all and conducive to learning. We follow the values expressed in the BC Human Rights Code, by providing a school community that is free of discrimination and harassment.

Expectations:

Our students are expected to behave in a respectful manner and contribute positively to the school environment. As our students age through their three years at Monterey, the expectation is they will demonstrate increasingly responsible and self-aware behaviour.

At Monterey we foster the following three levels of respect. As part of this students should demonstrate:

Respect for Self:

- Putting in your best
- Being on time for school and attending every day
- Using behaviour and language appropriate to a public setting

Respect for Others:

- By being kind, safe and positive
- Accepting others for who they are
- By not interfering with their learning

Respect for our School:

- By helping keep the grounds and building clean and in good order
- Acting in a manner that brings credit to Monterey

Personal Electronic Devices:

Student devices are required to be in lockers during the school day, unless specifically directed by a teacher to use them. Any other use of these devices will result in confiscation and a call home to ask the parent/guardian to pick up the device at their convenience.
